Mr. Suehrstedt holds a BSE in Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering from the University of Michigan. He joined Bath Iron Works Corporation (BIW) in 1981 and has held positions in the Planning, Production Control, Manufacturing and Engineering divisions. He is an Associate Member of the Society of Naval Architects and Marine Engineers and was a member of the industry core group that developed and wrote the National Shipbuilding Research Program (NSRP) Strategic Investment Plan in 1998. Mr. Suehrstedt also serves as an adjunct lecturer for MIT's Professional Summer Program.

Mr. Suehrstedt is currently the Director of New Business and Trade Planning, responsible for production trade planning activities and leading the planning efforts for bid and proposal work at BIW. In this capacity he was responsible for the recently completed implementation of DELMIA and the integration of DELMIA with BIW's legacy systems. Prior assignments included Director of Production Design, which encompassed the structural loft, waterfront design liaison and manufacturing engineering functions; Manager of Planning and Material Control at BIW's steel fabrication facility; and an assignment to Saint John Shipbuilding, Ltd., developing production plans and schedules for the Canadian Patrol Frigate Program.
